

## STUDY: ABROAD



## Estimated Expenses: London: Study & Internships at University of Westminster

Tuition and a program fee will be billed to your DePaul Student Financial Account for the term(s) you will be abroad. Tuition is the amount assessed for the number of credit hours of coursework. Each student has a different tuition rate dependent on college and year admitted to DePaul, and financial aid also varies by student. Additional estimated\* program costs will not be billed to the student account, are paid by students directly, and vary across students based on spending habits.

A. Program Fee and Tuition (Billed by DePaul)
